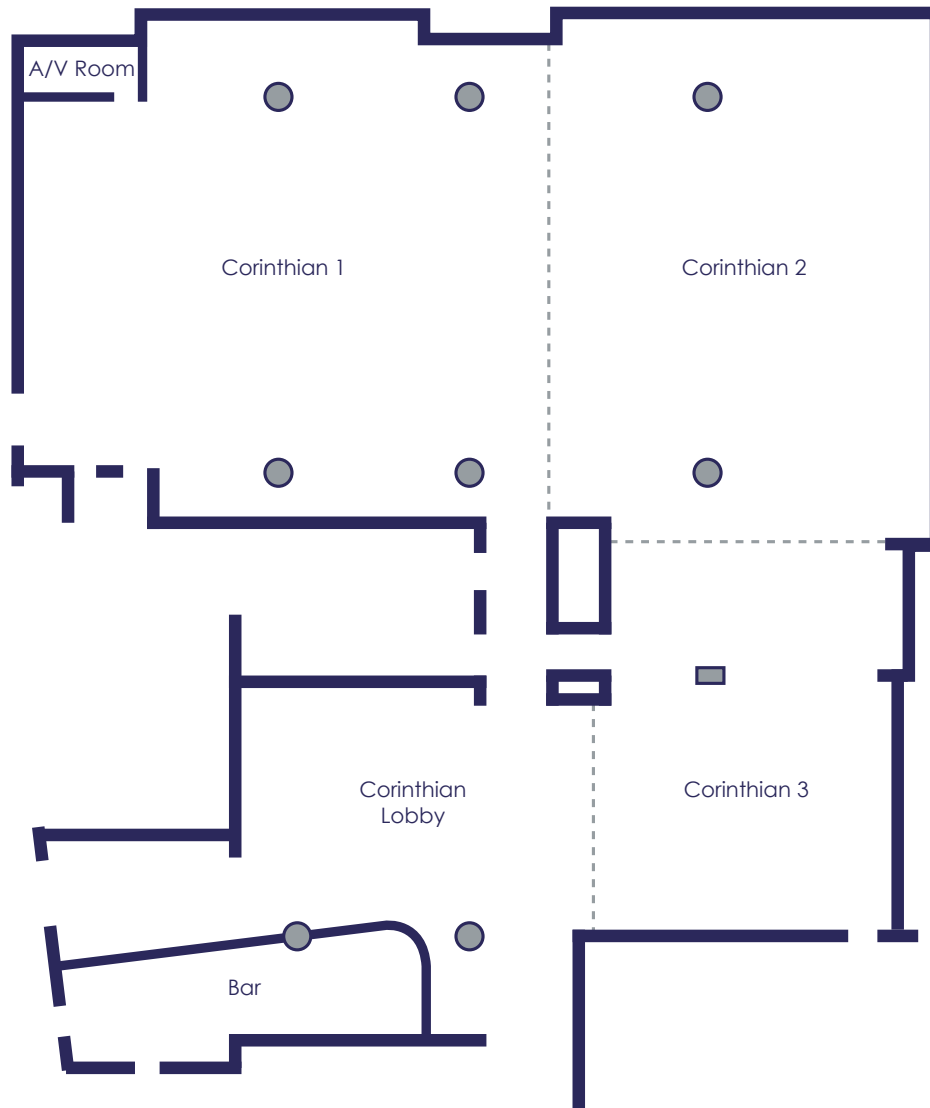

Named after the ballroom in the old City Hotel which was famous for Ballroom dancing in the 1960's.



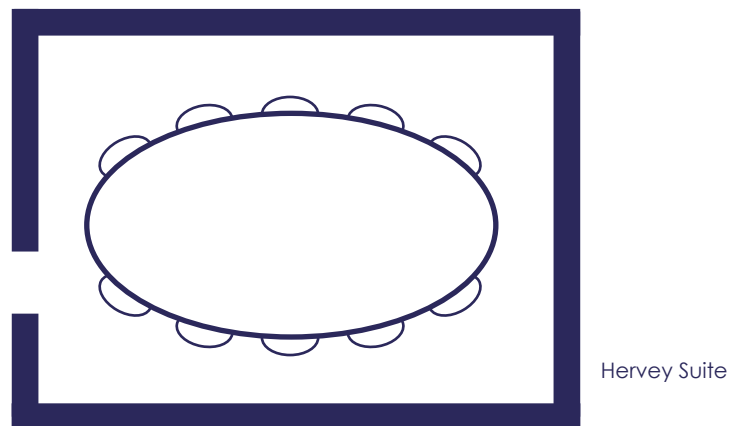
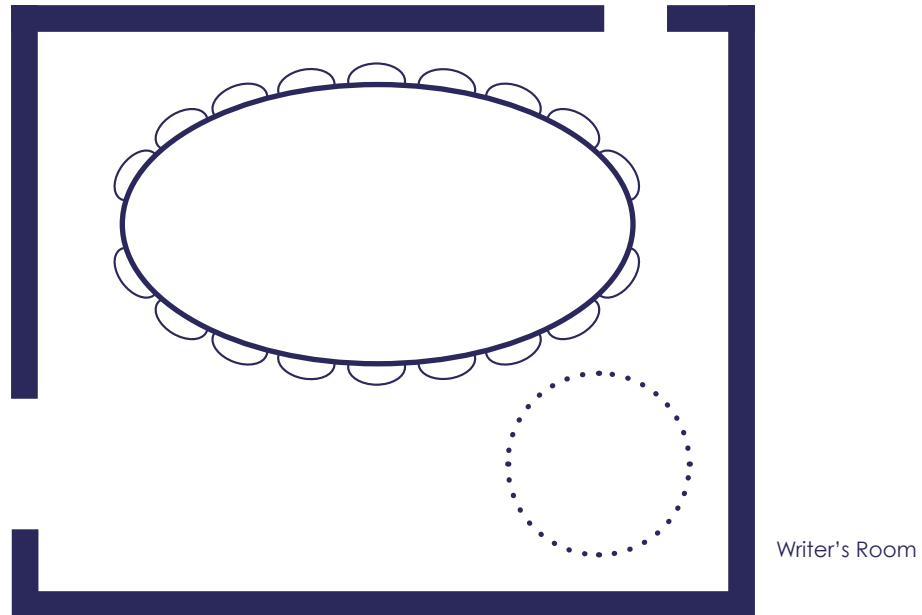

Writers Room & Hervey Suite

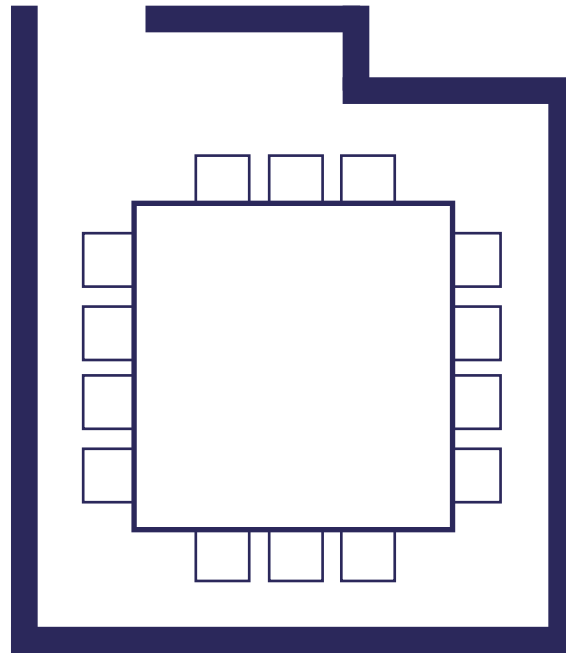

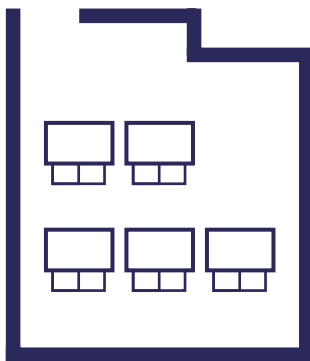

Berkeley Suite

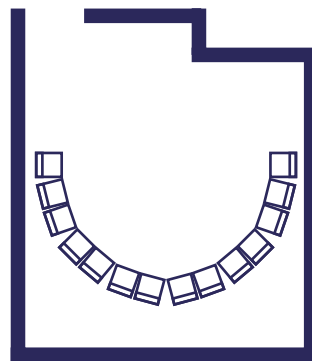
The Berkeley Suite is named after Dr. George Berkeley who was made Dean of Derry in 1724.



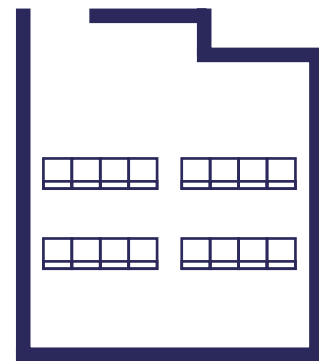

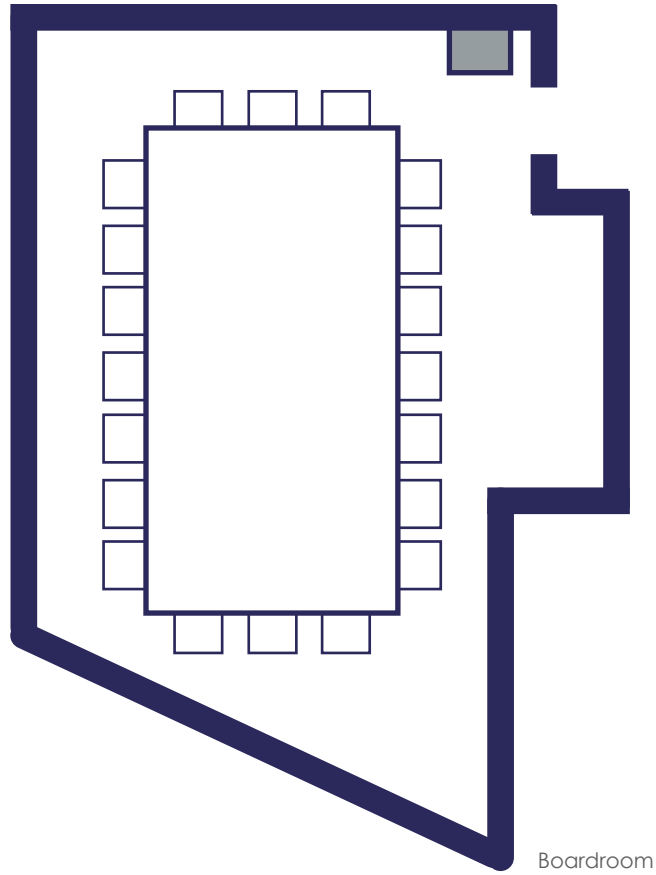

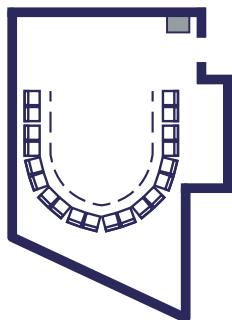

McCorkell Suite

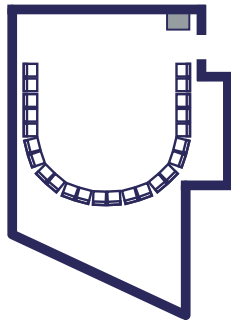
The McCorkell Suite is named after the McCorkell Line Ship building company which operated in the city between 1860 and 1896 and built the famous Minnehaha Ship.



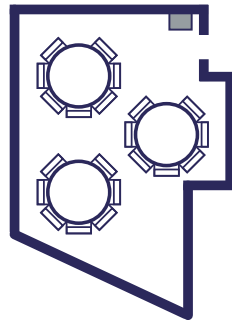

Amelia Suite

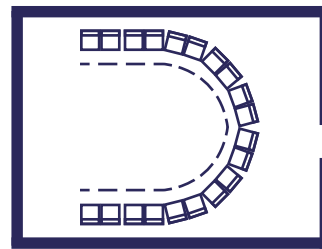

Alexander Suite

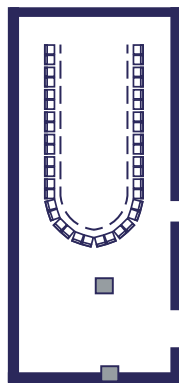

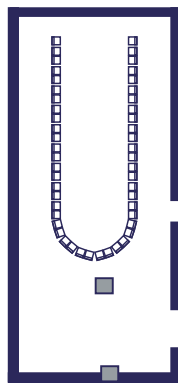

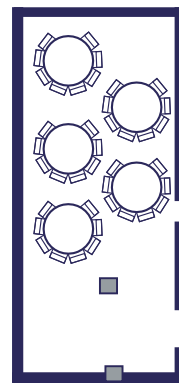
